## KSEI to Introduce an Auto Pre-Matching Facility - Update

Further to our previous newsflash, the Indonesia Central Securities Depository (KSEI) has introduced a new automated pre-matching for OTC transactions in its system, the Central Depository and Book-Entry Settlement System (C-BEST).

With the new facility, depository participants will be able to pre-match their clients' instructions electronically and to monitor the matching status of their settlement instructions in C-BEST. However, this will also depend on the concerned counterparties, whether they have also input their settlement instructions under this module.

At this stage, KSEI has just provided the feature in C-BEST to perform market socialisation, and to allow participants to conduct testing, Therefore, the use of the new facility is not mandatory.
