Consultation on CSD Regulation and Harmonisation of Settlement Cycles in EU

On 13 January 2011, the European Commission launched a public consultation the regulation of Central Securities Depositores (CSDs) and the harmonisation of settlement (including a uniform T+2 cycle) across Europe. The Commission is seeking stakeholders' comments on the potential design of a common regulatory framework for CSDs as well as on measures to be taken to achieve efficient securities settlement.

Following the consultation, which will last until 1 March 2011, the Commission will analyse the responses and is expected to issue a legislative proposal in June 2011.
