# Consultation on Financial Markets Bill

The National Treasury is seeking public comment on the Financial Markets Bill, 2011. The Bill will replace the Securities Services Act No. 36 of 2004 that has governed the regulation of securities services in South Africa since 2005. The Bill will provide for a stronger regulatory framework, more effective supervision, improved crisis resolution, and enhanced accountability by:

- strengthening the Self-Regulatory Organisation model of supervision
- aligning financial market regulation with international best practice
- giving effect to recommendations made by the 2008 Word Bank and International Monetary Fund Financial Sector Assessment Programme
- implementing South Africa's commitment to the UNIDROIT Convention to improve investor protection in cross-border transactions
- ensuring alignment between the legislation that governs financial markets and the wider legislative framework, including the new Companies Act and the Consumer Protection Act

Comments must be submitted to the National Treasury by 5 September 2011. The related documents are available here: Financial Markets Bill.
